

WEEK FOUR: CREATION

Big Idea: God _____ about all of his creation.

HANG OUT What part of nature do you care about the most? How do you show care for God's creation?
Have you ever planted a tree? Done a neighbourhood trash pickup? Helped care for an animal?

HEAR **Read Genesis 9:12-17.**

What was the rainbow a sign of?
Why do you think God didn't just make this sign for people, but for all living creatures?
Do you think God cares about how we treat animals? Lakes, rivers, oceans? Plants and trees? Why?

As a group, decide on one action to take together to show care for God's creation and all living creatures. Brainstorm different ideas and then act on at least one of them. (E.g. Community trash clean up, volunteer at an animal shelter, plant a tree.)

What are you going to do? When are you going to do it? Who will be involved? What do you need to do to get ready for it?

HUDDLE Sometimes people think kids' can't do big things simply because they are kids. That's not true. You can because you are part of God's team, and he can help you. Thinking about God's creation, what is one thing you'd like to pray about? Pray together.
