

WEEK FOUR: Tower of Babel

Big Idea: Put God first.

HANG OUT Using building blocks, have children build the biggest tower they can.
Ask: Why do you think people want to build tall towers?
Say, "A long time ago, people would try to build tall towers to show that they were the very best. They did it to make themselves famous. They did it to make themselves number one."
Ask, "But we know that we aren't supposed to be number one. We aren't supposed to put 'me first' - who should we put first?"

HEAR **Read** the story of the Tower of Babel in Genesis 11:1-9.
Ask:
Why did the people put themselves first?
Who should we put first?
Why do you think we should put God first? Who loves us the very best?
How can we put God first every day? (Use the back page to answer.)

HUDDLE Ask children if there is anything they would like to pray about:
Do you want to say thanks to God for something? Do you want to ask for God's help? Do you want to ask God to help someone who is sick?

Pray together.
