**Big Idea:** God helps us \_\_\_\_\_ who he created us to be.

## **HEAR Recap the God Story:**

Why did David think he could win? Why didn't David wear King Saul's armour?  
How did David win? What practice did he have before?  
How did being a shepherd help David in this situation?

Many leaders that God partnered with in the Old Testament were shepherds first, like David. And as David grew, God used David's shepherd-heart-who-cares-for-his-sheep to care for God's people. God helped David be who he created him to be: a shepherd of people. Look up and **read Psalm 23** to see how David learned how to be a shepherd from God.

**HUDDLE** God wants to help me and you be who he created us to be.  
List a few different characteristics that others would use to describe you (e.g. kind, loving, wise, organized, energetic, etc.).  
Then ask: why might God have made me \_\_\_\_\_? How can I use that to be who he created me to be? How can I serve God with that characteristic?  
On the back of the page, draw a picture of yourself using that characteristic to serve God and/or others in some way.
