

WEEK TWO: Gone Fishing

Big Idea: Working without Jesus doesn't work.

HANG OUT Have you ever had to do a whole bunch of work by yourself? (A chore? School project? Farm work?) What was it? How long did it take you? If you had the choice to work with someone to help you or not, would you take it? Why or why not?

Highlight the Big Idea, and talk about what that means (e.g. will Jesus do our chores for us? No—but why is working with Jesus better for us?).

HEAR Look up and read John 6:1-15.
What would the disciples have done without Jesus?
What could the disciples do with Jesus?
How did working with Jesus change everything in this story?
We might not have this type of situation in our lives (with loads of food being multiplied!) but we will see times when we could work without Jesus or we could work with Jesus and there is a difference. What might that look like for us?

HUDDLE How do you remind yourself of Jesus in your every day life? At school or at home or while playing a sport or doing a hobby? How is Jesus present with you in those times?

Pray for each other that you would all be reminded of Jesus in your every day life, and that we can choose to work with Jesus in everything.

Bonus: On the back, draw a picture of the John 6 story of what would have happened without Jesus, and then what happened with Jesus.

Write a news story about the "Good News" message of Jesus.
