

# WEEK TWO: Religions

## Big Question: Are all religions true?

**HANG OUT** Before you begin, use some items to set up a pretend campfire (or do this around a real campfire if able!). Items to make a pretend campfire could include: brown construction paper (roll and tape to look like logs), orange/yellow/red tissue paper to look like flames, and a small tea light to put under the tissue.

ASK: Do you have friends who are from different religions? Do you know what they believe? Are there parts of their religions that have things that are similar to what we believe?

**HEAR** Look up and read Acts 17:22-32. Who is speaking? Who is he speaking to? How does he use something from their religion to point to Jesus?

Sometimes it can feel tough for people to talk about Jesus in regular conversation, but it doesn't have to be. Take time to ask other people what they believe. Listen carefully. Be willing to share with them about Jesus, too.

**HUDDLE** Do you have friends that ever ask you about going to church or Jesus? What do you tell them? What do you think Jesus would like them to know? Take time to discuss and pray together.

Brainstorm together ways that you can easily talk to other people about Jesus.
