

WEEK FIVE: Science and God

Big Question: Do we have to choose between science and the Bible?

HANG OUT Before you begin, use some items to set up a pretend campfire (or do this around a real campfire if able!). Items to make a pretend campfire could include: brown construction paper (roll and tape to look like logs), orange/yellow/red tissue paper to look like flames, and a small tea light to put under the tissue.

ASK: What is your favourite thing to learn about in science? Why? Is there anything about science you don't really like? What? Why?

If you have a magnifying glass, take a close look at some things like a leaf, a hand, an insect. Look at all the unique parts of them.

HEAR Look up and read Psalm 19:1-6 and Romans 1:20.

God is the God of science. He is the creative force behind things we call scientific. Think about how complex different creatures are. Science shows us how all these things work. God created them for a purpose!
