Big Idea

We can experience God's love when we are faithful.

Conversation Starters:

Get ideas flowing by sharing some of your own ideas too!

Use these questions to get your kids thinking about the Big Idea.

- What does it mean to be faithful?
- Is there a person you know that is a faithful friend? Who?

Video:

Watch this week's video.

Pray & Discuss:

After the video take time to talk about it together.

- What was the Life Story about in today's video? What was the God Story about?
- What miracle did Jesus do in the God Story? (Luke 7:1-10)
- The man in the story was showing great faith. How did he do that?
- How can we show great faith in Jesus? What are some times when it might be difficult to faithfully follow Jesus?
- **Pray:** Thank God for loving us the same when we are faithful and when we are not but help us to be faithful to you in all things. Help us to know and trust Jesus in all things. Amen.

Hidden Message Activity:

Prep: Print out the activity page.

Supplies:

- Give your kid the activity page and colouring supplies.
- Help them discover the hidden message through colouring.
- Once you find the message talk about what it means for you and your family.
- When finished, hang it somewhere in your house that you will see it through the week.

Supplies:

- Key verse sign

Review the key verse together. Discuss:

- Who is the verse about? What does it tell us about God?
- Can you think of a time God has comforted you?

Learn the Key Verse together by using the actions printed below. See if you can lead the verse without using the written words and simply remembering them through the actions.
