

WEEK ONE: Noah

Big Idea: God keeps his promises.

HANGOUT

1. Say, "I promise I will jump three times with you!" Then prompt everyone to jump three times with you. Repeat several times with new promises to show the children what it looks like to make a promise and then keep it.
2. Discuss:
 - a. Have you ever made a promise? If so, did you keep it?
 - b. Is it hard to keep a promise?
 - c. Did you know there's someone who ALWAYS keeps his promises?

HEAR

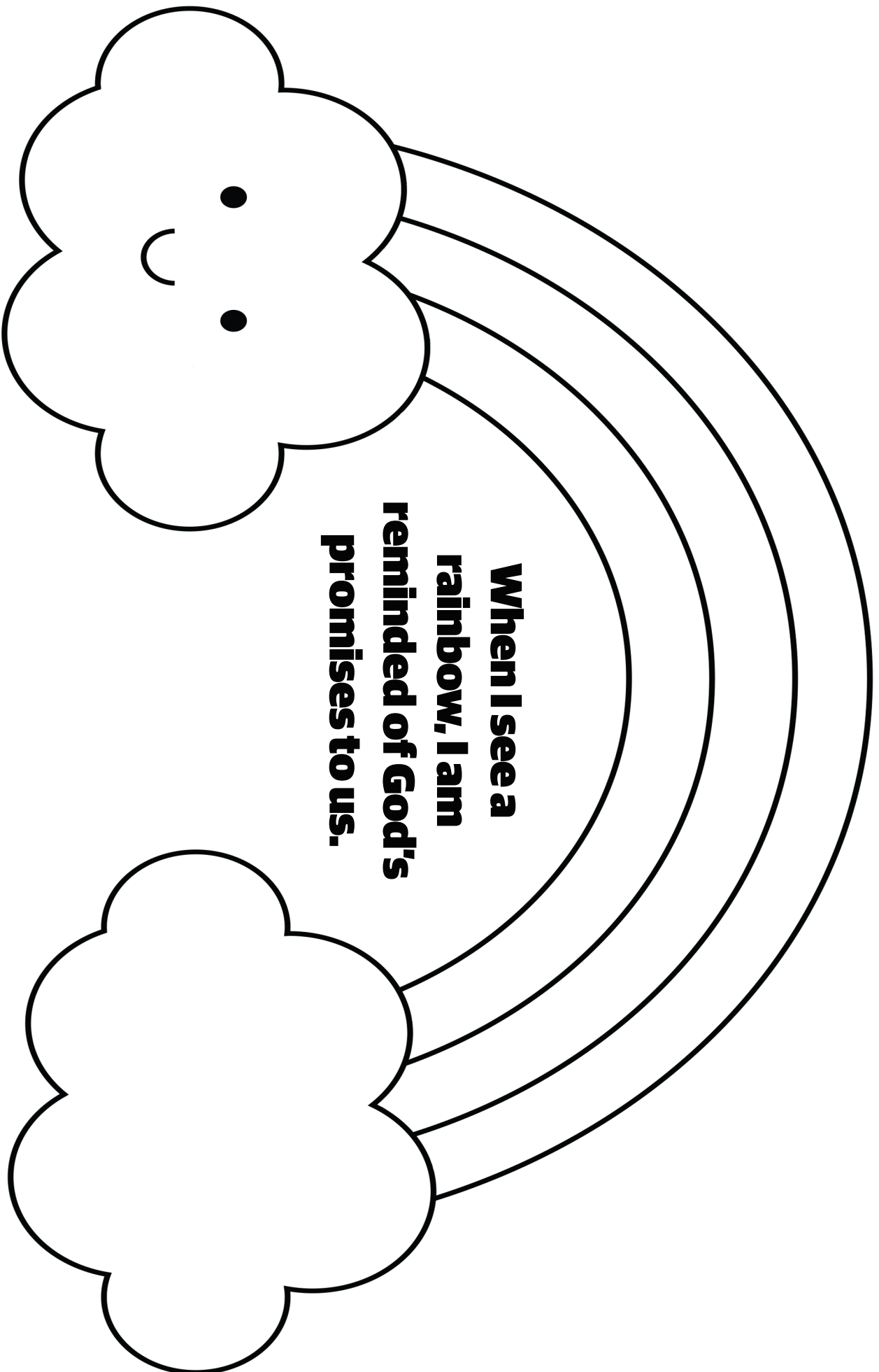
3. Look up and read the story of Noah and the ark (Genesis 6-9) in a children's Bible.
4. Emphasize that God promised Noah that his family would be safe from harm if he listened. God kept his promise!
5. Discuss: Do you know any other promises that God made in the Bible?

HUDDLE

6. Say, "God promises to love you always! What do you want to say to God about that?"
7. Pray together.

Bonus Activity:

Consider using washable paints and encourage the children to finger-paint the rainbow activity page. Or encourage the children to use their fingertips to create a dabbed-in rainbow!
